## SCOUTING THE BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern rides a two-game winning streak into Saturday's game at Gardner-Webb, and have fresh legs after enjoying an open date this past weekend ... Two of the Bucs' three losses this season have come to teams currently ranked in the FBS Top 25 (Florida and South Florida) ... Offensively, quarterback **A.J. Toscano** (897 passing yards, 4 TD, 205 total offense yards per game) has taken over the Bucs' always potent spread offense and has a favorite target in All-America candidate **Gerald Stevenson** (25 catches, 150.4 all purpose yards per game) ... Stevenson leads the team in rushing and receiving, and remains the league's most dangerous return man ... **Kwame Krakue** (18 catches) and **Tim Jones** (19.8 ypc) are also part of the Bucs' deep corps of receivers, while shifty running back **Antwan Ivey** keys the running game ... Newcomer **Joel Walton** paces the Bucs' defense with two sacks in 2009, with safety **Chris Kuzdale** (23 tackles) and linebacker **Charles Godfrey** (23 tackles) lead the defense in total hits ... Veteran **Andrew McKain** (19 tackles) is also a player to watch for the Bucs on defense (4-2-5 scheme) ... Coach **Jay Mills** has more wins (36) than any other coach in Charleston Southern football history, and has more than half of the program's win total since football began in 1991.

## 2009 GARDNER-WEBB FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### HEAD COACH STEVE PATTON

Steve Patton has averaged nearly seven wins per season in his 12 years with the Gardner-Webb program, and has the Bulldogs in strong shape again in 2009. The Oneonta, Ala., native became the first coach in Big South history to record 100 career wins in 2007, and now has 110 victories in his 17 seasons of coaching on the collegiate level. Patton has recorded a 80-56 record during his 13 seasons at Gardner-Webb, giving him more wins than any coach to lead the program before him.



The Runnin' Bulldogs sent receiver Dobson Collins to the NFL (San Francisco) in 2008, marking the second season in a row that a GWU player had either signed a free agent deal or been drafted by the league.

Collins and linebacker Jeffery Williams earned All-America honors and Williams was named Big South Defensive Player of the Year – following up strongly on his Freshman of the Year Award from the previous season.

In 2007, Brian Johnston earned consensus All-America honors and was drafted in the seventh round by Kansas City. Linebacker Mario Brown and cornerback Cedric McGowan were named honorable mention All-America by The Sports Network, Williams earned Big South Freshman of the Year honors after setting a new pace with 120 total hits in 2007.

Patton, a two-time Big South Coach of the Year, directed the 'Dogs to a 6-5 record in 2006, the ninth winning season in his 11-year tenure in Boiling Springs. All five of those losses came at the hands of teams ranked at some point during the season as members of the Division I FCS top-25 – including national champion Appalachian State.

The success of 2006 came with one of the youngest rosters in Division I, with 74 percent of the Bulldogs' team holding membership in either the freshman or sophomore class. Five of the team's six wins came against Division I competition, and Johnston was named Big South Defensive Player of the Year and a Division I FCS All-American by the Associated Press and Football Gazette. Linebacker Brown and center Kris King also earned All-America honors, with King accepting a roster spot for the U.S. National Team at the 2007 World Cup of Football in Japan.

Kicker Hunter Smith was named to the Division I FCS Athletic Director's Academic All-Star Team, and was highly decorated on and off the field – becoming the first student-athlete in Big South football history to earn All-Conference honors in four consecutive seasons.

GWU has played one of the toughest collections of teams in the Big South over the past four seasons. Of Gardner-Webb's five wins in 2004, two came against teams that were ranked in the NCAA Division I FCS top-25 at some point during the season, and four of the losses came against teams who capped top-25 seasons in November. The same can be said for 2005, as GWU fell in overtime to a top-15 squad, and dropped two more games to top-10 teams Furman and Hampton.

Patton has forged a solid program, winning 51 games at the Division I level. Since joining the Big South Conference in 2002, Gardner-Webb has gone 15-8 during five seasons of competition – with league titles won in 2002 and 2003 with undefeated ledgers.

Notable in terms of the strength of Gardner-Webb's non-conference schedule since 2004 is that 13 of the Bulldogs' last 18 non-league losses have come at the hands of either top-25 FCS teams or teams from the Bowl Championship Subdivision – including last season's 10-7 loss at eventual top-25 member Georgia Tech.

During Patton's tenure, 31 GWU players have earned All-America honors, and another 101 have earned All-Big South honors since 2002.

Gardner-Webb posted seven-straight winning seasons under Patton from 1997-2003, posting a strong 9-1 record and I-AA top-25 finish in both major polls in 2002. GWU was 7-4 in its first Division I season (2000), and forged an 8-3 record in Patton's first season – 1997 – marking the top turnaround of any school on the Division II level.

Patton has also served as a college head coach at North Greenville and Mars Hill. He has served as an assistant coach at The Citadel and his alma mater, Furman. Patton also has professional head coaching experience, most recently with the Arena Football League's Charlotte Rage in the early 1990s.

Patton and his wife, Debbie, have two daughters – Stetson and Shelby.

### THE GAME

Gardner-Webb returns to Big South Conference action Saturday (Oct. 17), hosting Charleston Southern in what is believed to be the earliest start time for a home game in school history – with kickoff set for 11:30 am in Spangler Stadium. Saturday's game will air live on SportSouth (Time Warner Cable Channel 60, DirectTV Channel 649), with Mark Bryant and Brian Jordan calling the action. The game will also air, as usual, on WGWG-FM (88.3), with Fabian Fuentes and Jared Pankhurst providing the call (wgwg.org).

### SERIES NOTES

Gardner-Webb holds a 6-3-0 edge in the all-time series, which began in 1992 ... Charleston Southern has been hot of late in the matchup, winning three of the last four meetings – including a 38-7 win on Gardner-Webb's homecoming in 2005 ... Each of the past two meetings have been decided by a combined seven points, with Gardner-Webb winning 29-25 at home on Oct. 27, 2007 (SportSouth) and CSU hitting a late field goal to win 13-10 on Oct. 4, 2008 in Charleston ... GWU head coach Steve Patton is 4-3 in his career against the Bucs ... Jay Mills is 3-3 against GWU.

### AGAINST THE FCS

Gardner-Webb is 2-0 against Football Championship Subdivision foes this season, winning on the road at Western Carolina (Sept. 12) and at VMI (Oct. 3) ... In those two games, the Runnin' Bulldogs have flourished offensively, averaging 27.0 points, 382.5 yards and nearly 24 first downs per game ... Against its own subdivision, Gardner-Webb has converted 53 percent of its 38 third down chances and has scored six touchdowns in 10 trips inside the red zone (80 percent total conversion rate, 2 FGs) ... Receiver James Perry III has flourished against the FCS, averaging nine catches for 115 yards in the two games so far ... By contrast, GWU is averaging just 214.0 yards per game against its two FBS opponents, while allowing 492.5 yards per game.

### LAST TIME AGAINST THE BUCS

Gardner-Webb posted 23 first downs and 471 offensive yards last season at Charleston Southern, but four turnovers in key situations hampered the Bulldogs' chances at a road win – as CSU's John Paglia boomed a field goal with one second remaining for a 13-10 win by the Buccaneers. GWU had driven 87 yards on 15 plays to get inside the Bucs' 10-yard line with less than a minute to play, but Patrick Hall slipped and fumbled on a third down run that appeared headed to paydirt. Hall recovered, but GWU was forced to kick a tying field goal instead of going for a go-ahead score. Gerald Stevenson then worked his return magic for CSU, setting the Bucs up with a very short field. CSU got close enough, as Paglia was left with a 26-yard field goal that he made with plenty of room to spare for the win.

### MR. 4,000

Quarterback Stan Doolittle (6-3, 224, Sr.) became the seventh man in Gardner-Webb history to top the 4,000-yard mark passing on Saturday at Buffalo, and now sits in 7th place on the school's all-time list with 4,006 yards and 21 touchdown passes to his credit – despite missing half of the 2008 season and a large chunk of 2006 with injuries. Doolittle paces the Big South this season in passing yards (216.8 ypg) and total offense (241.8 ypg), while accounting for six touchdowns (four passing, two rushing). The Ninety Six, S.C., native has been named Big South Conference Choice Hotels Offensive Player of the Week twice through five starts in 2009. He passed for a career-high 310 yards last season vs. CSU, but was picked off three times in that game. Doolittle has passed for 510 yards (255.0 ypg) in two starts vs. the Buccaneers.

### YARD STICKS

- Gardner-Webb paced the Big South Conference with nine of its student-athletes named to this year's preseason All-Conference team, which was voted on by the league's head coaches and members of the media.
- Both of Gardner-Webb's losses this season have come to FBS opponents who played in bowl games last season (NC State and Buffalo).
- Gardner-Webb has seven redshirt seniors on its preseason roster, and 19 total seniors.
- A total of 24 players on the 2009 roster, including redshirt juniors, have at least four years of college experience.
- Gardner-Webb wrapped up its longest road trip as a Division I member (since 2000) with a 2-2 mark.
- Gardner-Webb has received votes in the Sports Network FCS Top 25 poll in each of the past six weeks, marking the longest stretch of receiving votes for the program since the 2003 season (8-4 finish).
- Gardner-Webb's 11:30 am kickoff with Charleston Southern on October 17 (SportSouth) will mark the earliest start time for a home football game in program history.
- GWU will play five of its final six games during daylight hours.
- Dobson Collins, an honorable mention FCS All-America selection in 2008, was waived on the final day of cuts by the San Francisco 49ers, but was one of eight players signed to the 49ers' practice squad.
- Senior corner Cedric McGowan (Greer, S.C.), a two-time All-Big South selection, will redshirt in 2009.
- Gardner-Webb has not won a game on live television since defeating Charleston Southern, 29-25, on Oct. 26, 2007 in Boiling Springs (SportsSouth). GWU is 5-9 all-time when playing on television (since 2003).

### THE GOODS

Defensive tackle **Matt Goods** (6-2, 285, Fr.) has been a virtual microwave for the Gardner-Webb defensive line in 2009, coming off the bench to record 21 tackles, a team-high 7.5 tackles for loss and 3.5 quarterback sacks. The East Orange, N.J., native prepped at Milford (N.Y.) Academy in 2008, and was rated the nation's No. 7 postgraduate defensive tackle prospect by Rivals.com, a national recruiting website. Goods earned his third Big South Conference Freshman of the Week award following the VMI game, registering six tackles, a tackle for loss and a fourth-quarter fumble recovery that set up Gardner-Webb's winning touchdown drive. He showed considerable hustle in the team's loss at Buffalo, contributing three tackles, a half tackle for loss and a blocked extra point.

### PROFIT MARGIN

Through its first four games in 2009, Gardner-Webb ranks third in the nation (Football Championship Subdivision) in turnover margin, averaging an edge of +2.2 miscues per game. The Runnin' Bulldogs have forced 14 turnovers (five interceptions, nine fumbles), while turning it over just three – two tipped-pass interceptions and a muffed punt fumble. GWU's lone turnover at VMI snapped a streak of 230 consecutive plays without a miscue. The team has not lost a fumble in 180 rushing attempts so far in 2009.

### THE BIG SOUTH NETWORK

Four of Gardner-Webb's home football games, and all of the team's road games within league play, will appear live this season as part of the Big South Conference's revamped online video streaming service – The Big South Network. The subscription service is available at [bigsouthsports.com](http://bigsouthsports.com), and brings the league's football into living rooms world wide. Saturday's game with Charleston Southern will not be streamed live, as a result of the game's appearance on live television (SportSouth / Fox College Sports Pacific).

### DYNAMIC DUO

Veteran broadcaster **Fabian Fuentes** returns again to headline the Runnin' Bulldog Radio Network, handling play-by-play duties for Gardner-Webb football for his 12th season. The Jacksonville, Fla., native has earned some of his profession's top accolades during his career, which dates back to the early 1990s. Joining Fuentes in the booth for all 11 regular season games in 2009 will be Gardner-Webb alumnus **Jared Pankhurst** for his first full season. Pankhurst, also a Jacksonville, Fla., native, has served as the Bulldogs' sideline reporter, has handled spot play-by-play duty and has followed GWU football closely since arriving on campus in 2003. As usual, all Gardner-Webb games will be carried live on the University's 50,000-watt flagship station, WGWG (88.3). The games will also be available online via the station's website ([wgwg.org](http://wgwg.org)).

### BIG SOUTH'S FIRST STAR RETURNS TO LEAGUE SIDELINES

Gardner-Webb made a notable addition to its coaching staff recently, hiring the Big South Conference's first Offensive Player of the Year – former GWU quarterback **Jeremy Martin** – as a graduate assistant coach. The Middletown, R.I., native will coach the tight ends in 2009, and is a bright offensive mind who is very familiar with the team's offensive system. During his time in Boiling Springs, Martin finished as the program's second-leading passer, completing 633-of-1,175 career passes (54.0 percent) for 8,025 yards and 60 touchdowns. His career pass efficiency rating (121.97) is the best in school history among quarterbacks with at least 1,000 attempts. Martin earned the Big South's first Player of the Year trophy in style, passing for 2,166 yards and 17 touchdowns with only four interceptions in 2002. That effort helped Gardner-Webb to a 9-1 record and the Big South's first football championship – along with a final regular season ranking of #18 from **The Sports Network** and #19 from **USAToday**.

### WILLIAMS STEPS IN FOR PRESEASON HONORS

Junior linebacker **Jeffery Williams** (6-0, 229) has picked up where he left off last season in the awards category, garnering preseason All-America honors from six different organizations and publications heading into 2009. The Frisco City, Ala., native has collected 266 career tackles in 27 games – and was also recently named to the preseason Buck Buchanan Award Watch List by the Sports Network. Williams, who was a two-way star at tiny Frisco City High in Alabama, led that state in tackles with 19.6 per game as a senior – and averaged 10.2 yards per carry for six touchdowns on offense. Williams ranks 20th in GWU history in career tackles. He has been strong vs. Football Bowl Subdivision opponents, averaging 8.5 tackles per game against four FBS foes – including 11 stops at Mississippi State in 2007.

### NOT TO BE FORGOTTEN

A forgotten man last season for Gardner-Webb defensively was two-time All-America selection **Mario Brown** (6-2, 239, Sr.), who was granted a medical redshirt after suffering an injury prior to the Bulldogs' second game of the season. Brown, a native of Greenville, S.C., has returned to full speed since then – and earned preseason second-team All-America honors from the Sports Network in June. Brown was also named the league's top defensive player by The Sporting News this preseason. Brown (team-high 29 hits in 2009) reached the 250-tackle plateau at NC State, and has 269 career tackles in Boiling Springs. He had 14 hits at Buffalo, moving him into a tie with former All-America defensive end Brian Johnston for 18th on the career tackling list at Gardner-Webb.

### EXPERIENCED DEPTH

Gardner-Webb, which had a roster made up of 74 percent underclassmen (freshmen, sophomores) in 2007, has finally gotten some age on its two-deep. Of the 60 total slots on the team's depth chart (offense, defense and special teams), 36 are manned by players in at least their third season in a senior college football program (60.0 percent).

### SEASONED LINEBACKERS PACE DEFENSE

Gardner-Webb enters the 2009 season with one of the nation's most experienced, and talented, groups of linebackers. Preseason All-America selections **Jeffery Williams** (6-0, 229, Jr.) and **Mario Brown** (6-2, 240, R Sr.) anchor that unit, combining with veterans **Marty Patterson** (6-3, 215, Jr.), **Oluwadamilola Teniola** (5-11, 227, Jr.) and **Quan Jackson** (5-11, 203, Sr.) to start 96 career games between them. The quintet, with at least 15 career starts each, has now compiled 923 tackles, 84 tackles for loss and 22 sacks during their collective careers in Boiling Springs. Patterson (15 stops) and Brown (14 stops) combined for nearly 30 hits at Buffalo on Oct. 10.

### GATES TOPS 100, CONTINUES TORRID PACE

**Ryan Gates'** leg has been productive since his arrival in Boiling Springs last August, and the All-America sophomore continued to build on his legacy in the season opener. The Newnan, Ga., native boomed all seven of his extra point attempts and connected on a perfect 3-of-3 field goals to score a Big South-record 16 points. That production earned Gates the league's Special Teams Player of the Week award. Gates, who set a new GWU freshman mark with 75 points en route to All-Conference honors in 2008, reached the century mark for his career in scoring at Western Carolina, booting a pair of field goals and three extra points. Gates leads the Big South with 39 points scored and field goals per game so far in 2009, connecting on eight through five games. Gates is currently on pace to score 314 points for his career (44 games, four seasons), which would demolish the current Gardner-Webb scoring record of 278 points held by future Hall of Famer Jeff Parker (1986-1989). Gates' field goals per game average would give the youngster 66 made field goals should he keep up his current pace. The current career record at GWU for field goals, also held by Parker, is 45.

### OTHER PRESEASON PROJECTIONS

Gardner-Webb, picked fourth by the Big South coaches/media, and first by Phil Steele's *College Football Preview Magazine*, was projected totally different by other publications. *The Sporting News / Street & Smith's College Football Preview* picked the Runnin' Bulldogs third in its preseason poll. *Lindy's* projected the 'Dogs as the fifth-place finisher in the seven-team Big South Conference. *The Sporting News* picked Liberty as its preseason favorite, while *Lindy's* went with Coastal Carolina.

### THIS WEEK IN THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

In other Big South Conference action on opening Saturday: VMI hosts Stony Brook (1:30 pm); Liberty hosts Coastal Carolina (3:30 pm); Presbyterian is idle. The weekend marks the first time more than two league games have been played.

### MR. ROGERS NEIGHBORHOOD

Safety **Darren Rogers** (6-1, 215, Sr.) transferred to Gardner-Webb last season after playing quarterback and receiver at Kent State, and moved to safety prior to the start of 2009 spring practice. With injuries depleting the position late in the win at Western Carolina, Rogers – a native of Ambridge, Pa. – was forced into the starting lineup. He has responded very well. His play at VMI earned him Big South Defensive Player of the Week honors, and he followed with nine tackles (seven solo) and a pass break up at Buffalo on Oct. 10. Rogers ranks third on the team currently with 27 total tackles (14 solo), 2.0 tackles for loss, two interceptions and three pass break ups.

### HALL & PEOPLES

Running backs **Patrick Hall** (5-11, 220, Jr.) and **Philip Peoples** (6-0, 227, Sr.) have each flourished in short yardage roles during their respective careers with the Runnin' Bulldogs, and both are slowly climbing the rushing touchdowns chart at GWU. Hall (14 career rushing touchdowns) is tied for 10th in school history, and has a team-best four rushing scores this season. Peoples, who recently moved into the career top-20 with 1,286 rushing yards, is tied for 13th all-time with 13 rushing touchdowns. One of Hall's best games came against Charleston Southern two seasons ago in Boiling Springs (Oct. 27), when he rushed 13 times for 100 yards and a pair of scores in Gardner-Webb's 29-25 win.

### UP NEXT

Gardner-Webb steps out of league play for the final time, hosting Southern Virginia at 6 pm ET on Saturday, October 24 in Spangler Stadium. The game will be carried live on WGWG-FM (88.3), and will be broadcast via internet video stream as part of the Big South Network. †

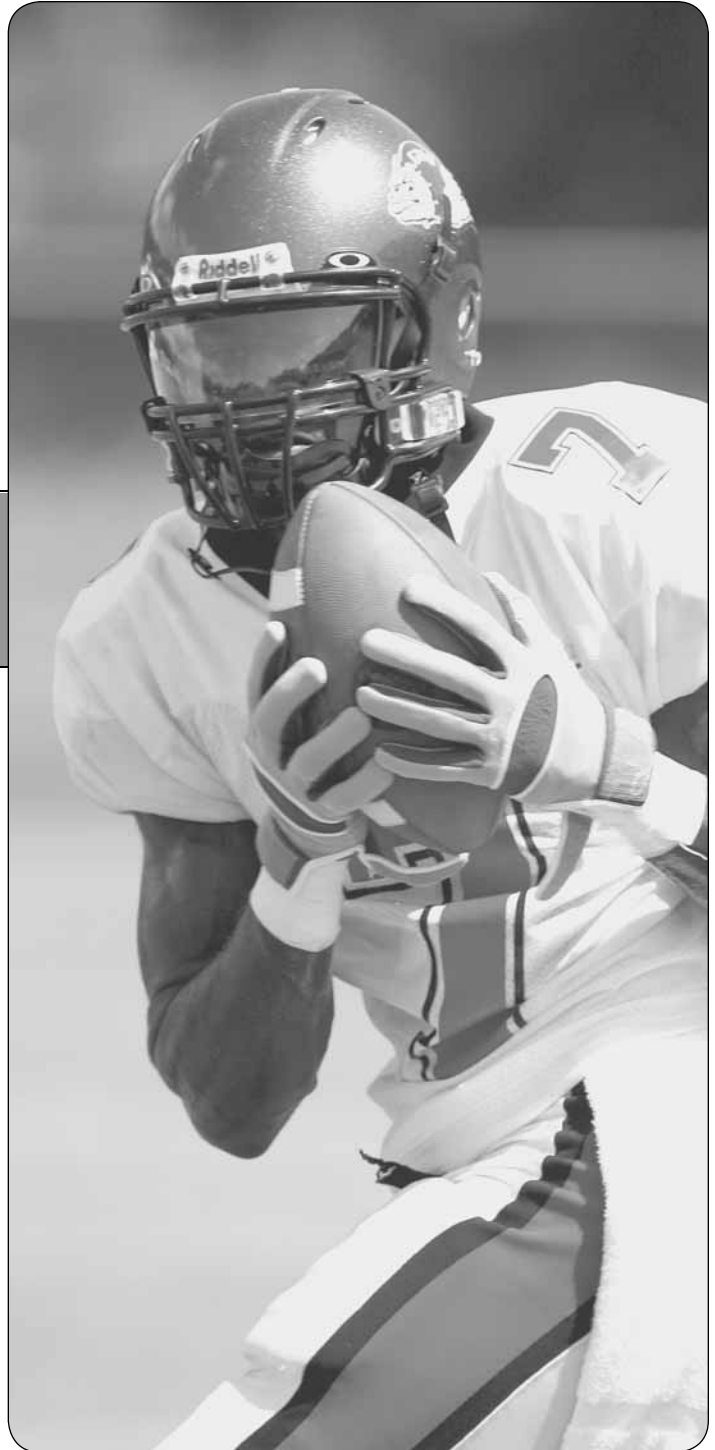

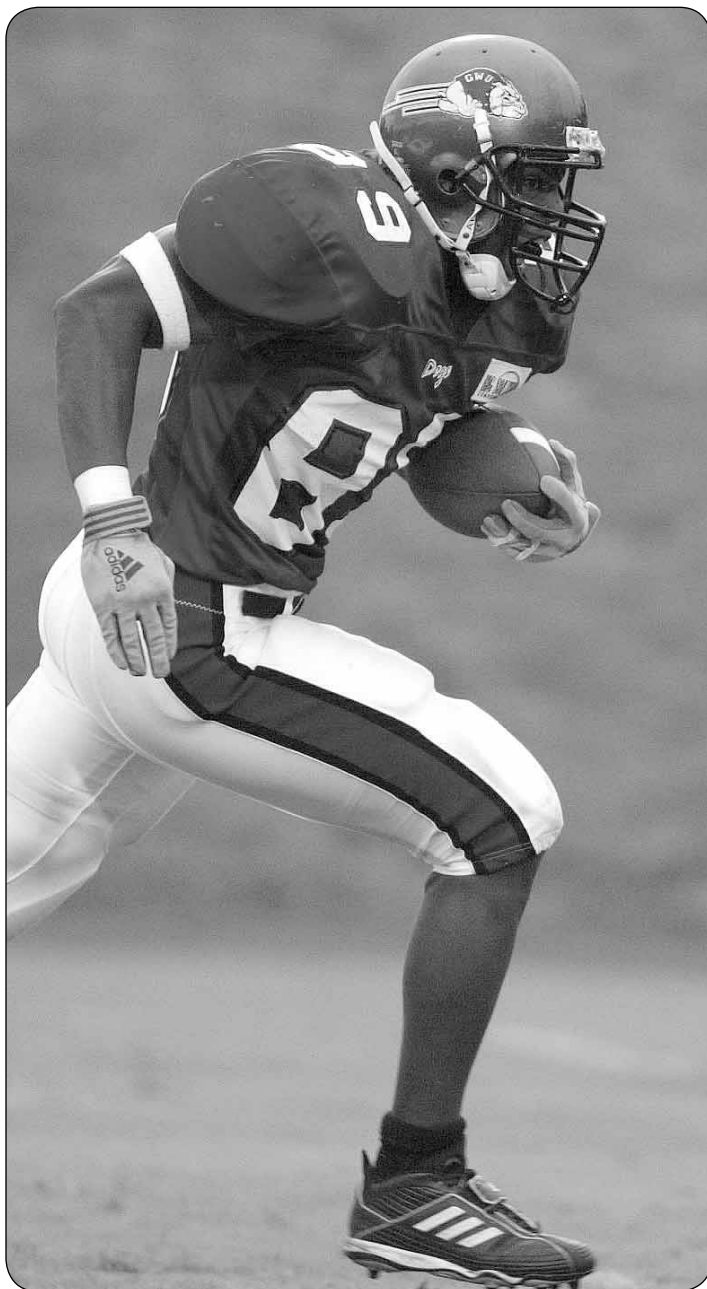
